



# Camp Wignall Daycare Dog Schedule

7am-9am

**Top O' The Morning:** Dogs check in at any point during this time frame. If your dog has not eaten breakfast because they were too excited to come to daycare, no problem! You can bring it with you and we will feed them. Even if you forget their food, we have Hills® Sensitive Stomach dry food on hand to give them if needed.

9am-12pm

**Fetch, Stretch and Flex:** Group play time is supervised off leash in our fenced in, turfed outdoor play yard! We even have an indoor play space for those not so pleasant days. We have plenty of toys for the dogs to choose their favorite to play with. Some may be content mingling and playing with their friends. We also have kiddie pools for the pups that love swimming. Only in the warmer months of course. Dogs are split up into 2 or 3 groups depending on size and/or temperament and will spend a minimum of 1 hour outside during this time and up to 2 hours. Right before each group is concluded, their kennels are checked for any accidents or spilled bowls. \*For new dogs, their first few days may consist of smaller shortened groups for proper acclimation. All depending on how comfortable your dog feels.\*

12pm-1pm

**Lunch, Snacks, and Nap Time Oh My:** Everyone is given fresh water after they come in from their outdoor play time. They are placed back in their kennel runs (with a treat) to relax. We give their muscles and heart rates time to wind down before we give them their lunch (if provided or requested). Then the pups are soothed into nap time with some classical music.

1pm-4pm

**Afternoon Adventures:** More group play time outside/inside with toys, pools, and friends! Pups are out for about the same time as the morning play group: at least 1 hour and up to 2 hours. Kennels are checked again for accidents or spilled bowls.

4pm-5pm

**Rest & Relaxation:** Time to take a break from rough housing with their friends so they can catch their breath and take a quick power nap to recharge for some more play. Dogs will get fresh water and another treat at this time.

5pm-7pm

**Evening Escapades:** Pups are taken out one more time and are usually outside or in our indoor playroom until they get picked up to go home. One staff member will be outside with our dogs and one will be inside handling check outs and cleaning. (Due to staff being split up, dogs with behavior concerns may not be placed in this group due to safety reasons. These dogs are taken out to play and go potty before the group.)
